CSVT Work Update

Montoursville, PA – Work is progressing on the Northern Section of the Central Susquehanna Valley Transportation (CSVT) project in Northumberland, Union and Snyder counties as follows:

River Bridge:

Trumbull Corp. is the prime contractor on this part of the project.

One pier is expected to be completed in August. Then, all substructures will be completed.

Steel girders have been erected on nine of 15 spans. Erection of girders is expected to be completed by the end of the year.

The bridge deck is being prepared for concrete placement. This work will be performed in three sections. The first section is expected to be completed this year; the second two sections will be completed next year.

The river bridge is expected to be completed in the fall of 2020 but will not open until the northern section paving is completed in 2022.

Northumberland County:

Trumbull Corp. is the prime contractor on this part of the project.

The bridge over Wooded Run is the only structure left to be completed. This work will be completed this fall.

Northern Section Paving:

The contractor, New Enterprise Stone and Lime Co., Inc., has completed soil stabilization and is constructing the subbase.

Concrete paving is expected to begin in August.

This work is expected to be completed in 2022, at which time the CSVT's northern section will be open to traffic.
