CSVT Update for Upcoming Week

Montoursville, **PA** – Work is progressing on the Northern Section of the Central Susquehanna Valley Transportation (CSVT) project in Northumberland, Union and Snyder counties as follows:

Winfield Interchange:

Earthwork will continue during daylight and evening hours. Daylight lane restrictions on Route 15 southbound will be implemented as weather permits for work at a bridge abutment. Blasting will occur during the day with intermittent stoppages in both directions on Route 15.

Northumberland County:

Route 147 traffic is using a temporary crossover to the new northbound bridge over Chillisquaque Creek. The contractor is demolishing the existing bridge over the creek. Construction continues on the bridge spanning Ridge Road.

River Bridge:

Construction of Piers 1 through 8 and the bridge abutment will continue on the west side of the river. Piers 4, 5 and 7 are completed. Concrete is scheduled to be placed for Pier 1 and Pier 8, and possibly the abutment, next week.

Steel girders were delivered this week and are scheduled to be set in place next week. Structural steel is expected to be delivered to the project next week. Minor delays on Route15 near Winfield can be expected during daylight hours. Motorists should be alert and be prepared to stop.

Construction is ongoing on the abutment on the Northumberland side of the river. Concrete is scheduled to be placed for the abutment wall.
