CSVT Project to Close a Portion of Mill, Airport, and App Roads in Monroe Township, Snyder County

Montoursville, PA – Construction continues on the Southern Section of the Central Susquehanna Valley Transportation (CSVT) project in Snyder County.

On Saturday, July 8, 2023, a portion of Mill, Airport, and App Roads will be closed in Monroe Township, Snyder County for numerous construction projects. Work on these projects include building of two roundabouts, re-alignment of Airport Road, and construction of an embankment for the CSVT alignment.

Road Closures and Long-Term Detour

Mill Road will be closed between Penns Drive and Greenbriar Avenue. A detour using Route 204, Route 522, Routes 11/15, and Route 1017 (Park Road) will be in place until December of 2023, weather permitting.

Airport Road and App Road will be closed at the intersection with Mill Road. A detour using Route 11/15, and Route 1017 (Park Road) will be in place until December of 2023, weather permitting.

Motorists should be alert, slow down, expect delays in travel and drive with caution.
