CSVT Updates

Montoursville, PA – Construction continues on the Northern Section of the Central Susquehanna Valley Transportation (CSVT) project in Northumberland, Union and Snyder counties as follows:

Traffic Alert

Beginning Monday, June 14, Route 15 northbound will have daily lane closures. The northbound right (driving) lane near the future interchange south of Winfield will be closed during the day and reopened each evening.

Route 15 southbound right (driving) lane will continue to have the long-term lane closure while work is performed on the sign structure foundations.

Other Construction Updates

Construction activities continue on both sides of the River Bridge. The prime contractor, New Enterprise Stone and Lime Co., Inc., has completed most of the mainline concrete paving on the Northumberland side and is working on concrete paving operations near the future Winfield interchange.
