Dear Snyder County Commissioners:

The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) has notified the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture that it intends to condemn certain land that is within an agricultural security area established under authority of the Agricultural Area Security Law (Act) (3 P.S. § 901 *et seq.*).

The land that is proposed for condemnation lies within Monroe Township, Snyder County. The proposed condemnation would be for highway purposes related to PennDOT's Central Susquehanna Valley Transportation (CSVT) Project.

A hearing to take testimony on this proposed condemnation request has been scheduled for August 26, 2020 at 10:00 A.M. Due to the current disaster emergency relating to the COVID-19 presence, and in accordance with Governor Tom Wolf's July 10, 2020 Order authorizing Commonwealth agencies to conduct administrative proceedings online by video or telephonic means, this hearing will be conducted by online conference.
