CSVT Update for Week of May 15

Montoursville, **PA** – Work is progressing on the Northern Section of the Central Susquehanna Valley Transportation (CSVT) project as follows:

Beginning Monday, work associated with construction of the Route 15 Interchange in Union Township, Union County, will begin with the construction of acceleration and deceleration lanes on Route 15 north of Granger Road.

The passing lanes on Route 15 will be closed in both directions while work is completed in the median. The closure will allow the contractor to construct an acceleration lane on Route 15 north from Granger Road, and a deceleration lane on Route 15 south to Granger Road.

This work is expected to take about two weeks to complete.

The second week of an approximately two-week detour continues for Ridge Road in Point Township, Northumberland County. The detour, which uses Route 147 and Route 11, is needed while tie-in work related to the relocation of a section of Ridge Road and its intersection with Route 147 is being performed.

The relocated Ridge Road is expected to be opened later this summer.

Excavation, blasting, drainage work, bridge work and utility work along Route 147 will continue with limited lane closures under flagging.

Work continues on the river bridge piers on the west side of the river. This work includes construction of earth retaining systems and concrete piers.
